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BACKGROUND

On November 3, 2005, the Real Estate Appraisers Board issued a Final Decision and Order adopting a Stipulation filed by the parties in the above-captioned matter.

On January 4, 2006, Mr. Schlesselman, by Attorney Randall Lueders, submitted a request for removal of the limitations placed on his Licensed Appraiser credential. The Board considered Mr. Schlesselman's request at its meeting on March 1, 2006. Based upon the record, the Real Estate Appraisers Board issues the following order:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the conditions and limitation placed upon the Licensed Appraiser credential (#04-997) of Charles J. Schlesselman pursuant to the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated November 3, 2005, be removed and that respondent's license be, and hereby is, restored to full licensure. As provided in Wis. Adm. Code s. RL 81.05 (3), Respondent may perform appraisals of commercial real estate having a transaction value of not more than \$250,000.

This order is effective on the date on which it is signed by a designee of the Board.
