PROCEDURAL HISTORY

A hearing in the above-captioned matter was held on February 23, 2006, before Administrative Law Judge Jacquelynn B. Rothstein. The Division of Enforcement appeared by Attorney John N. Schweitzer. Attorney Eric D. Hylden appeared on behalf of Ms. Yeager.

Based on the entire record in this case, the undersigned administrative law judge recommends that the Real Estate Board adopt as its final decision in this matter the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. A formal complaint was filed against Ms. Yeager on or about January 10, 2006.
- 2. A hearing in the above-captioned matter was held on February 23, 2006
- 3. Ms. Yeager unexpectedly died in an automobile accident on March 22, 2006.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Real Estate Board has jurisdiction in this matter pursuant to §452.14, Wis. Stats.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this matter be DISMISSED.

OPINION

Due to Ms. Yeager's death, this action has become moot. The undersigned has therefore recommended that the matter be dismissed. Attached are copies of Ms. Yeager's obituary, along with a copy of a local newspaper account of the automobile accident in which she was involved.
