PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Richard L. Jones-Witthuhn, D.V.M., (DOB 06/06/1950) is duly licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the state of Wisconsin (license #50-2987). This license was first granted on 06/08/1987.
2. Dr. Jones-Witthuhn's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is N7494 950<sup>th</sup> Street, River Falls, WI 54022.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Dr. Jones-Witthuhn was working as a veterinarian for Kinnicroix Vet Clinic, 1055 East Cascade, River Falls, Wisconsin 54022.
4. Dr. Jones-Witthuhn practiced with an expired Wisconsin veterinary medicine license (#50-2987) from approximately January 1, 2004 and continuing on to July 28, 2004, when the license was renewed.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 453.04 and 453.07. and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described in paragraph 4, above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § VE 7.06(20).

## ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Richard L. Jones-Witthuhn, D.V.M. (license #50-2987) is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Richard L. Jones-Witthuhn, D.V.M. shall pay costs in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be submitted within ninety (90) days from the date of this order.
