PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Hearing and Speech Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Richard L. Beyer, Respondent, date of birth November 24, 1959, is licensed by the Wisconsin Hearing and Speech Examining Board as a hearing instrument specialist in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 1167, which was first granted June 7, 1999. Respondent's address of record is 8373 Serenity Lane, Pulaski, WI 54162. Respondent's office address is Miracle-Ear, 2154 S. Ridge Road, Green Bay, WI 54304.
2. Respondent failed to renew his hearing instrument license when it expired on February 1, 2003. From February 1, 2003 until July 14, 2004, Respondent practiced as a hearing instrument specialist without a current license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. The Wisconsin Hearing and Speech Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 459.10 and has authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- B. Respondent, by practicing as a hearing instrument specialist without holding a current license, violated Wis. Stat. § 459.02(1) and is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 459.10(1)(e).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Respondent, Richard L. Beyer, is hereby REPRIMANDED for the above conduct.
2. Respondent shall, within 120 days of the date of this Order, pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing partial Costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$250 pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.22(2).
