ORDER DENYING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On June 8, 2006, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a A.P.N.P and RN in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order dated June 26, 2006, provided that the suspension was stayed upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on her license. Included among these were that respondent follow all the conditions of the impairment order and not drink alcohol or consume controlled substances.

On November 14, 2006, the board considered evidence that Mr. Tushkowski had consumed alcohol and tested positive at a level of 0.253 on November 8, 2006. Accordingly, the board revokes the stay of suspension. The suspension is hereby reinstated upon respondent showing compliance with all the terms and conditions of the Final Decision & Order for a period of six months.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Anthony P Tushkowski RN, APNP, is suspended indefinitely.
