PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

The Department Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. John J. Webb (“Respondent”), date of birth 07/09/47, is licensed as a private security person having license #108 006373. This license was first granted on 12/22/97.
2. The last reported address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing (“Department”) for the Respondent is: P.O. Box 3543, Janesville, Wisconsin 53547.
3. Respondent is currently employed at Advanced Security & Investigation Corporation (“ASI”). ASI is a private detective agency having license #062 008003. This license was first granted on 08/22/88.
4. On or about February 23, 2004, the Respondent was convicted of a misdemeanor for disorderly conduct, in the Circuit of Rock County, Wisconsin. A true and correct copy of the Criminal Complaint and Judgment of Conviction is attached as Exl and is incorporated by reference.
5. On or about November 15, 2004, Department records indicate the Respondent submitted an online renewal application to the Department for renewal of his private security person credential. The Respondent answered “NO” to the question of: “Have you been convicted within the past two years of a felony, misdemeanor or a violation of any state or local law (other than traffic) that is punishable by a forfeiture, or, are charges pending? (If yes, provide information.)”
6. The Department’s investigation revealed that the Respondent made a material misrepresentation on his renewal

application to the Department when he answered “NO” to the question concerning whether or not he had been “convicted within the past two years of a felony, misdemeanor or violation of any state or local law...”

7. The Department’s investigation revealed that the Respondent failed to report his misdemeanor conviction within the forty-eight (48) hour time period, as required by Wis. Stats. §§ 440.26 (4m); 440.26 (6)(a)1.; and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01 (2).
8. The Department’s investigation also revealed that the Respondent was non-responsive to two letters sent to him during the investigation of this matter.
9. In resolution of this matter, the Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.21.
2. The Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44 (5).
3. Respondent, John J. Webb has violated:
 - a. Wis. Stats. §§ 440.26 (4m); 440.26 (6)(a)1.2. and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01 (2) by failing to report his misdemeanor conviction within the forty-eight hour time period as specified by law;
 - b. Wis. Stat. §§ 440.26 (6)(a) 3.4. and Wis. Admin. Code §§ RL 35.01 (17)(18) by providing false information to the Department on his renewal application and;
 - c. Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01 (23) by failing to respond to two requests by a Department investigator.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
2. Respondent John J. Webb, license #108 006373, be, and hereby is, REPRIMANDED.
3. Respondent John J. Webb, shall, within 90 days of the date of this Order, pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event that John J. Webb fails to timely submit payment of the costs as set forth above, the private security permit for John J. Webb (# 108 006373) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further hearing and without further Order of the Department, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said costs has been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and their failure to pay the costs shall be considered a violation of

this Order by the Department.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file 05 RSG 010, be and hereby is, closed as to Respondent John J. Webb.
