## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Aurora Pharmacy, 4601 Old Peshtigo Road, Marinette, Wisconsin, is duly licensed as a pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin (license #42-8228). This license was first granted on September 11, 2002.
- 2. In April 2004, Aurora Pharmacy failed to have a reporting procedure in place and failed to file a Report of Theft or Loss of Controlled Substances form as provided in Wis. Admin. Code § Phar 8.02(3)(f) when they terminated a pharmacist for drug diversion.
- 3. In resolution of this matter, Aurora Pharmacy consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 450.10, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.44(5).
- 2. The conduct described in paragraph 2, above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Admin. Code § Phar 8.02(3)(f).

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Aurora Pharmacy (license #42-8228) is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

- 2. Respondent shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay a forfeiture of three hundred fifty (\$350.00) dollars.
- 3. Respondent shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars.
