PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Pharmacy Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jeffrey A. Swanson, R.Ph., (DOB 02/05/1949) is duly licensed as a pharmacist in the state of Wisconsin (license #40-8759). This license was granted on 01/09/1975.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board is 6102 W. Wisconsin Avenue, Wauwatosa, WI 53213.
3. From June 8, 2004 and continuing through September 23, 2005, Respondent worked as a pharmacist at Laabs, Inc. with an expired Wisconsin pharmacist license.
4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 450.10, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described in paragraph 3, above, constitutes a violation of Wis. Stat. § 450.03(1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Jeffrey A. Swanson, R.Ph. (license #40-8759), is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay a forfeiture of one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars.
3. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars.

5. In the event the Respondent fails to pay the forfeiture or the costs as ordered the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED until the Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
