A disciplinary proceeding was commenced in this matter by the filing of a Notice of Hearing and Complaint with the Board on or about 8/1/06. Before a hearing on the Complaint, the parties in this matter agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has now reviewed this Stipulation, and approves it.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Steven J. Jagemann (dob 2/18/55) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a dentist licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #2657, first granted on 1/8/81. Respondent is a general dentist.
- 2. On September, 30, 2005, Respondent's license to practice dentistry expired, and was not renewed. Respondent represents to the Board that his failure to renew was unintentional.
- 3. Notwithstanding this fact, Respondent continued to engage in the active practice of dentistry on substantially each and every business day between September 30, 2005, and January 30, 2006.
- 4. On January 30, 2006, Respondent paid his renewal fee (including the late fee) and attempted to renew his license to practice dentistry, but his license was not renewed, and Respondent did not receive biennial credentials from the Department of Regulation & Licensing, because he had not filed his 2001 Wisconsin Income Tax Return, and the Wisconsin Department of Revenue had so notified the Department of Regulation & Licensing, thus placing a "hold" on his license.
- 5. Respondent did not, until August 28, 2006, satisfy all of the Department of Revenue's requirements and therefore failed to obtain a release from that department until August 28, 2006, and thus failed to renew his license to practice dentistry until August 28, 2006. Notwithstanding this fact, he continued to engage in the active practice of dentistry on substantially each and every business day between January 30, 2006, and August 28, 2006.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- B. The conduct described in ¶¶3 and 5, above, violated Wis. Stat. § 447.07(3)(a), and Wis. Adm. Code § DE 5.02(26). Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Steven J. Jagemann, D.D.S., is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent shall FORFEIT \$1,000, to be paid within 30 days of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent shall pay the COSTS of investigating and prosecuting this matter in the amount of \$900, within 30 days of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.51(3), violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any

payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, or fails to pay costs as ordered, Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
