PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter, Joseph S. Jung, D.V.M., Respondent, personally and through his attorney, Steven P. Sager, Sager, Colwin, Samuelsen and Associates, S.C., and Pamela M. Stach, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Joseph S. Jung, DVM, (D/O/B 5/12/47) is currently licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Wisconsin under license #1563 which was first granted on June 18, 1976.
- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board is Community Animal Hospital, 161 N. Rolling Meadows Dr., Fond du Lac, WI. 54937.
 - 3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a veterinarian in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin.
 - 4. A formal investigation entitled 03 Vet 036 is pending before the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board.
 - 5. During the course of the investigation, medical records for the animal patient were obtained from the Respondent.
- 6. The animal patient records do not contain the information required under the provisions of Wis. Admin. Code sec. VE 7.03.
- 7. Respondent has cooperated throughout this investigation and, in order to resolve this matter, has voluntarily agreed to entry of this Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 453.04, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order pursuant to Wis. Stat. sec. 227.44(5).
- 2. Respondent's medical records for the animal patient do not meet the requirements of Wis. Admin. Code sec. VE 7.03 and are therefore in violation of Wis. Admin. Code sec. VE 7.15.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Stipulation of the parties, as attached hereto, is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that

- 1. Joseph S. Jung, D.V.M. shall, within nine months of the effective date of this Order, complete the record keeping course offered through the University of Wisconsin, School of Veterinary Medicine. The course may not be used in satisfaction of the biennial continuing education requirement for continued licensure.
- 2. Within 30 days after the course identified in paragraph one above is concluded, Dr. Jung shall file with the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board a certification from the School of Veterinary Medicine verifying his attendance at the required course.
 - 3. All costs of the educational program shall be the responsibility of the Dr.

Jung.

- 4. Within six months of completion of the course set forth in paragraph one above, the Board, or its representative, shall randomly select five patient records created by Respondent following completion of the course. The records shall be reviewed by the Board or its representative to determine whether they are in compliance with the provisions of Wis. Admin. Code sec. VE 7.03.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Jung shall pay costs in this matter of Five Hundred Eighty Nine dollars (\$589.00) within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the pending investigation 03 VET 036 is hereby closed.

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education the Respondent's license (#1563) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
