## **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

- 1. Phyllis Ruth Johnson, R.N., was born on November 29, 1943, and is duly licensed as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 64391. This license was first granted on March 26, 1976.
- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is: 32372 Park Trail, P.O. Box 186, Center City, MN 55012.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a professional nurse at St. Croix Valley Good Samaritan Center in St. Croix Falls, Wisconsin.
- 4. Respondent admits that there is sufficient evidence for the Board to find that on June 13, 2004, and while employed as a professional nurse at St. Croix Valley Good Samaritan Center, Respondent diverted the controlled substance Lorazepam from hospital stock or waste, for her own personal use.
- 5. On June 16, 2004, Respondent was admitted to St. Croix Regional Medical Center for a possible drug overdose. Respondent's husband accompanied Respondent to the hospital, and brought with him a bag containing all the drugs that Respondent was taking. This included the following controlled substances for which Respondent did not have prescriptions: three different dose strengths of amitriptyline, Roxicet, trazodone, Tylenol # 3, Vicodin, and lorazepam.
- 6. Respondent has not practiced nursing since June 13, 2004, has retired from the practice of nursing, and tenders the voluntary surrender of her license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §441.7(b), (c), and (d) and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §227.44(5).
- 2. The conduct described in paragraphs 4 and 5, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.03(2) and N 7.04(1), (2), and (15).

#### **ORDER**

# NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The stipulation of the parties is accepted.
- 2. That the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the license and privilege of Phyllis Ruth Johnson, R.N., to practice as a professional nurse in the state of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED. Respondent shall not practice nursing in Wisconsin, including under the Nurse Licensure Compact, without a Wisconsin license.
- 3. In the event Respondent shall ever re-apply for a license to practice as a nurse in the state of Wisconsin, she shall, in addition to all other requirements for licensure, demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Board of Nursing that she does not have a chemical dependence, and that she can safely and reliably perform nursing functions.
- 4. Respondent shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED FIFTY (\$550) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
