ORDER REMOVING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On October 12, 2006, the Board of Nursing issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that the suspension was stayed upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on her license. Included among these were that respondent not have access to controlled substances, not work as a pool nurse, provide employer(s) with copies of the Final Decision and Order, and to have her work setting pre-approved by the board or liaison.

On December 15, 2006, the board considered evidence that Ms. Bayer had not been in compliance with the limitations on her license by not informing her employer about her Final Decision & Order dated October 12, 2006, by not getting pre-approval by the board or liaison for her employment, for having access to controlled substances in her place of employment, working as a pool nurse and providing an unrestricted license to her employer when in fact her license is limited. Accordingly, the board revokes the stay of suspension. The suspension is hereby reinstated effective immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Christine A. Bayer, RN, is suspended for a period of at least six months.
