PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Janice S. Corbett, R.N., ("Respondent") was born on March 14, 1940, and is duly licensed as registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 123017. This license was first granted on June 14, 1996.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 21425 Orbit Avenue, Ontario, Wisconsin 54651.
3. From May 6, 2002, to June 28, 2002, Respondent was working as a professional nurse as a private duty nurse for Patient AP at his home in LaCrosse, Wisconsin.
4. After Patient AP terminated Respondent, and continuing until on or about December 17, 2002, Respondent continued to submit bills to Medicaid as if she were still providing services to Patient AP. Respondent was paid \$32,330.44 for payment of services she did not provide to Patient A.P.
5. For this conduct, on March 7, 2006, in Dane County Circuit Court, Respondent was convicted of the crime of submitting fraudulent insurance claims, in violation of Wis. Stat. s. 943.395(1)(a) and (2)(a).
6. Respondent has tendered the surrender of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin, in conjunction with her retirement.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. The conduct described in paragraphs 3-5, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(1) and (13).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Board accepts the SURRENDER of the license of Janice S. Corbett, R.N.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall not make application for re-instatement of the license.
3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing..
