FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Robert W. Evans (Applicant) has filed an application for a credential to practice as a private security person in Wisconsin.
- 2. Information received in the application process reflects that:
 - a. On or about September 1, 2005 Applicant was convicted of violation of Wis. Stat. § 947.01. [disorderly conduct];
 - b. On or about December 14, 2006 Applicant was convicted of violation of Wis. Stat. §943.01(1) [criminal damage to property]

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.
- 2. The facts and circumstances of the arrest referenced above substantially relate to the practice of a private security person. Applicant by his conduct is subject to action against his license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that ROBERT W. EVANS is GRANTED a PRIVATE SECURITY PERMIT subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Practice Limitations

1. Applicant shall provide a copy of this Final Decision and Order immediately to supervisory personnel at all settings where Applicant works or applies to work as a private security person.
2. Applicant shall work only in settings pre-approved by the Department.

Reporting Requirements

3. It is Applicant's responsibility to arrange for his security guard employer(s) to provide reports to the Department Monitor on a quarterly basis on a schedule as directed by Department Monitor. These reports shall describe the Applicant's activities and verify that he is in compliance with the laws governing the practice of a private security person and the terms of this Order. Applicant shall report immediately to the Department Monitor any violation or suspected violation of this Order.
4. Applicant shall comply with all terms of the judgment of conviction for Case #2006CM000864 imposed upon him, and shall submit proof of compliance to the Department, as directed by the Department Monitor.
5. Applicant shall report to the Department any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.
6. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall promptly notify Department Monitor of any suspected violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant

7. The Department Monitor is the individual designated by the department as its agent to coordinate compliance with the terms of this Order. Any requests, petitions, reports and other information required by this Order shall be mailed, e-mailed, faxed or delivered to:

Petitions for Modification

8. Applicant may petition the Department for modification of the terms of this Order after two years from the effective date of this order. Any such petition shall be accompanied by a written recommendation from Applicant's employer expressly supporting the specific modifications sought. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of Wis. Stats. § 227.01(3)(a), and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.

Costs of Compliance

9. Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with or associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Summary Suspension/Additional Discipline

10. The Department may in the exercise of its discretion revoke or suspend Applicant's limited license without further notice or hearing or other proceeding for any failure by Applicant to timely comply with the terms of this Order and/or for any further criminal conviction. Violations of this Order may in the alternative be the basis for a summary suspension under Wis. Admin. Code § RL Ch. 6 or separate disciplinary action under Wis. Stat. § 452.14.
