PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Sandra Johnson, D.O.B. 09/21/1972, is duly registered as a Private Security Person in the state of Wisconsin (permit # 108-30717). This permit was first issued on 04/13/2006 and expired on 08/31/06.
2. Ms. Johnson's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing is 3151 Whispering LN. E. Apt. 108, Memphis, TN 38115-0677.
3. On August 4, 2006, Ms. Johnson was convicted in the State of Wisconsin Milwaukee County Circuit Court of violating Wis. Stat. § 943.38(2), Forgery-Uttering, a Class H Felony.
4. Wisconsin Statute § 440.26(4m)(b) requires a license or permit holder who is convicted of a felony or misdemeanor to notify the Department in writing of the date, place and nature of the conviction within 48 hours after entry of the judgment of conviction. Ms. Johnson did not report her felony conviction to the Department. The Department learned about Ms. Johnson's conviction through her former employer, and verified her conviction through the Consolidated Court Automation Program (CCAP).
5. In resolution of this matter, Sandra Johnson consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondent Sandra Johnson has violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) by failing to notify the Department in writing of her conviction within 48 hours after the entry of the judgment of conviction.

3. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(b), the Department shall revoke the license or permit of any private security person who has been convicted of a felony in this state or elsewhere and who has not been pardoned for that felony. Ms. Johnson's felony conviction requires the revocation of her private security permit.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the RIGHT TO RENEW the Private Security Permit issued to Sandra Johnson, permit number 108-30717, is hereby **REVOKED**. Ms. Johnson shall cease and desist from acting as a private security person and from engaging in private security activities in Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all rights and privileges heretofore granted to Respondent Sandra Johnson pursuant to private security permit number 108-30717 are forever terminated effective at 11:59 P.M. on the date of this Order as set forth below.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent Sandra Johnson shall not be granted a credential under Wis. Stat. § 440.26 at any time in the future. The denial, in whole or in part, of any petition by Sandra Johnson for a credential authorized under Wis. Stat. § 440.26 shall not constitute denial of a license and shall not give rise to a contested case within the meaning of sections 227.01(3) and 227.42 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.
