FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Ramiro Aranda (Applicant) has filed an application for a credential to practice as a home inspector in the State of Wisconsii
- 2. Information received in the application process reflects that in 1990 Applicant was convicted of violation of Illinois Stat. [burglary]

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.97.
- 2. The facts and circumstances of the conviction referenced above substantially relate to the practice of a home inspector. Applicant by his conduct is subject to action against his license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.978.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Ramiro Aranda is GRANTED a HOME INSPECTOR LICENSE, subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Practice Limitations

- 1. Prior to commencing practice as a home inspector, Applicant shall submit an acceptable plan of supervision to the Department Monitor. Approval by the Department Monitor is required prior to Applicant working as a home inspector.
- 2. Applicant shall arrange for the submission of written reports to the Department Monitor on a quarterly basis, as directed by Department Monitor, relative to his supervision plan.
- 3. Applicant shall report to the Department any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.

Required Reporting

5. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall promptly notify Department Monitor of any suspected violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant as well as any failures of supervising adults to conform to the terms and conditions of this Order.

Petitions for Modification

6. Applicant may petition the Department for modification of the terms of this Order at any time following one year from the effective date of this Order. Any such petition shall be accompanied by a written recommendation from Applicant's treatment provider expressly supporting the specific modifications sought. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of Wis. Stats. § 227.01(3)(a), and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.

Costs of Compliance

7. Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with supervision and any other expenses associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Summary Suspension / Additional Discipline

8. The Department may revoke without further notice or hearing or other proceeding Applicant's permit for failure by Applicant to timely comply with the terms of this Order and/or for any further criminal conviction. A violation of this Order may alternatively be the basis for a summary suspension under Wis. Admin. Code § RL 6 or for separate disciplinary action under Wis. Stats. § 440.26(6).
