On June 27, 2007, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension of his license to practice pharmacy, as provided by the terms of the board's *Final Decision and Order*, ("*Order*") dated October 10, 2001. (Pire began practicing pharmacy under the *Order* June 1, 2004.) Pire requested the granting of an additional eight (8) hours per week to be worked as a pharmacist in charge, (currently at 16), and the request that he be allowed to open and close a pharmacy on the same day, (consecutively). The request was supported by his employer. Based upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., is granted a three-month stay of the suspension of license # 9468 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., is granted an additional eight (8) hours per week to be worked as a pharmacist in charge for a total of twenty four (24).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Thomas G. Pire, R.Ph., may open and close a pharmacy but NOT on the same day, (consecutively).
