On June 4, 2007, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Gerald F. Jennings, R.Ph., license # 10919, for a three month stay of suspension to be granted on his license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin as provided in the board’s *Final Decision and Order* dated November 14, 2001, (“*Order*”), and a request by Jennings that his therapy be reduced to two times per month from weekly. Based upon a review of the petition and supporting documentation submitted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Gerald F. Jennings, R.Ph., license # 10919 is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license #10919 to practice pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request to reduce therapy from one time per week to once every two weeks is hereby GRANTED.
