As reported by the department monitor to the board liaison for monitoring, Gregory J. Teche has been suspended by his drug and alcohol monitoring program, ("Approved Program") from November 27, 2006, to the present. Teche also failed to provide a urine sample for drug and alcohol screening on the following dates: 11/27/2006, 11/30/2006, 12/01/2006, 12/05/2006, 12/11/2006, 12/12/2006, 12/14/2006.

Teche's suspension from his Approved Program and failure to provide a urine sample as required by Board's *Final Decision and Order* dated November 12, 2002. ("*Order*"), violates paragraph 2b(4)d of the *Order*.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that pursuant to paragraph 8 of the *Order*, the stay of suspension for Gregory J. Teche, R.Ph., license number 10612, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, is hereby TERMINATED by action of the board liaison for monitoring, and Gregory J. Teche is hereby SUSPENDED from the practice of pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the board, the termination of the stay of suspension of Gregory J. Teche shall be reviewed by the board for further action.
