ORDER GRANTING A LIMITED LICENSE

On December 17, 2003, the Professional Counselor Section (Section) issued a Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the Board's Order, Mr. Burns's license to practice as a professional counselor was suspended for a minimum of two years. The Order further provided that Mr. Burns could apply for the termination of his suspension after two years provided he met several terms and conditions. Among those conditions, Mr. Burns was required to undergo a mental health assessment and to abide by the recommendations resulting from the assessment in the event the Section determined to end his suspension.

On July 31, 2007, the Professional Counselor Section reviewed the request of Mark C. Burns for a stay of suspension along with other supporting documentation. Based upon the Section's review,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mark C. Burns is granted a two year stay of suspension to practice as a licensed professional counselor in the State of Wisconsin subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) Mr. Burns shall remain in treatment with Kenneth E. Johnson, M.D, and follow his recommendations. Mr. Burns shall arrange to have Dr. Johnson submit written quarterly reports to the Section for its review.
- (2) Mr. Burns may only practice as a professional counselor under the supervision of Raymond Lueck, Psy.D. Mr. Burns shall provide Dr. Lueck with the Section's Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter and all subsequent, related Orders. Mr. Burns shall arrange to have Dr. Lueck submit written quarterly work reports to the Section. Dr. Lueck shall inform the Section immediately of any unsatisfactory work performance matters including, but not limited to, any alcohol or other drug related relapse.
- (3) Under the supervision of Dr. Lueck, Mr. Burns shall have his professional counseling practice limited as follows:
 - a. Mr. Burns shall have a face-to-face caseload limit of twenty-eight (28) patients over a maximum workweek of forty (40) hours.
 - b. Mr. Burns's caseload shall not include female patients with Borderline Personality Disorder, Histrionic Personality Disorder, or individuals with these tendencies. If Dr. Lueck determines that patients with these types of disorders are appropriate for Mr. Burns to treat, he may do so but only under close supervision provided by Dr. Lueck.
- (4) Mr. Burns shall obtain advance approval of the Section if he wishes to change his supervisor or employment setting.
