On March 1, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing considered the request of the petitioner for a further three month stay of the suspension of her limited license, pursuant to the Board Order dated January 15, 2004. The petition also requested a reduction in her AODA therapy, AA support group meetings and urinalysis screens. Based upon the information of record showing that petitioner is in compliance with her order, the Board now enters the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a three month stay of the suspension of the limited license of MICHELLE M. DONAR, L.P.N., (lic#29211) to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the State of Wisconsin is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's AODA therapy shall be reduced to quarterly; her attendance at AA support groups shall be reduced to 1 meeting per week and her urinalysis screens shall be reduced to fourteen (14) times per year.

This Order is effective upon the date of signing and is continuous from the date of the previous stay.
