On February 7, 2007, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated June 22, 2005. (“*Order*”) Also requested was a reduction in drug and alcohol screens to a frequency of 72 per year as provided by paragraph C.14. of the *Order*, and the granting of eight (8) hours to be worked as a pharmacist in charge as provided by paragraph C.21 and D.4. of the *Order*.

Based upon the board’s review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license # 12694, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the drug and alcohol screens required by the *Order* are reduced to a frequency of 72 per year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., is granted eight (8) hours to be worked as a pharmacist in charge at the Agnesian HealthCare pharmacy.
