ORDER REMOVING STAY OF SUSPENSION

On October 18, 2006, the Medical Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter. By the terms of the board's order, respondent's license to practice as a medical doctor in Wisconsin was suspended for an indefinite period. The Order provided that the suspension was stayed for a period of three months, with provision for successive stays conditioned upon respondent's compliance with certain conditions and limitations on his license. Included among these were that respondent participate in an approved drug and alcohol treatment program, that he participate in therapy, and that he attend AA or NA. Respondent was also required to participate in a drug screening program consisting of at least fifty-two screens per year.

On 01-09-2007, the board considered evidence that Dr. Lawrence Reich had not been in compliance with the limitations on his license by his therapist report of alcohol consumption and his own self report of lapse.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the license of Lawrence Reich, M.D., is hereby suspended effective immediately.
