**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

A formal Complaint was filed in this matter on 4/20/06, and an Answer has been filed. The Respondent and prosecutor in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent Nima [no middle name] Heshmati (dob 3-21-1974), is licensed as a physician and surgeon in Wisconsin pursuant to license #42931, first granted on 12-20-2000. He is certified by the American Board of Family Practice, and is also licensed in Florida.
2. On February 15, 2007, Respondent's license to practice medicine was disciplined by the Florida Board of Medicine. A copy of that Final Order is attached hereto, and incorporated by reference.
3. Respondent has completed the suspension imposed by the disciplinary order, and is under no further restriction by the Florida Board of Medicine.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

A. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

B. The conduct described in ¶2, above, violated Wis. Adm. Code § Med 10.02(2)(q). Such conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

**ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Nima Heshmati, M.D., is REPRIMANDED for his unprofessional conduct in this matter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Respondent shall pay the COSTS of investigating and prosecuting this matter of \$1,600, within 30 days of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.51(3) and § 448.02(4), violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit full payment of the costs as set forth above, Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
