The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Richard I. Wang (dob 10/12/24) is and was at all times relevant to the facts set forth herein a physician and surgeon licensed in the State of Wisconsin pursuant to license #14943, first granted on 4/20/64.
2. Respondent has entered into an agreement with the United States Department of Justice for settlement of their civil and criminal investigations of alleged upcoding and of alleged violations of the Controlled Substances Act. In resolution of this matter, respondent has agreed, among other things, to retire and surrender his registration.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- A. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- B. The conduct described in ¶2, above, if established, would violate § Med 10.02(2)(m), Wis. Adm. Code. Such conduct would constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of the Code and statutes.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the attached Stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the SURRENDER of the registration of the license to practice medicine and surgery of Richard I. Wang, M.D., is ACCEPTED, effective the date of this Order, at 11:59 PM. Respondent shall not register, or attempt to register, at any time in the future. Respondent shall not practice medicine without being registered.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that respondent shall preserve all patient health care records as required by Wis. Adm. Code § Med 21.03(1).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the COSTS of investigating and prosecuting this matter of \$700, are waived.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(4), if the Board determines that there is probable cause to believe that respondent has violated any term of this Final Decision and Order, the Board may order that the license of respondent be summarily suspended pending investigation of the alleged violation.
