PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Dentistry Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Douglas B. Neumann, D.D.S., ("Respondent") was born on May 24, 1943, and is licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 5000548. This license was first granted on June 17, 1968.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is 10401 W. Lincoln Avenue, Suite 202, West Allis, WI 53227.
3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was practicing dentistry in West Allis, Wisconsin.
4. Patient M.S. is a female born on June 3, 1987.
5. Patient M.S. was referred to Respondent by her orthodontist, for extraction of two deciduous teeth in preparation for orthodontic treatment.

6. On November 6, 2000, Respondent extracted the two deciduous teeth, but Respondent erroneously also extracted the impacted permanent tooth #11.

7 Respondent has closed his dental practice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 6, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § DE 5.02(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Douglas B. Neumann, D.D.S., is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of Two Hundred (\$200.00) dollars. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license(#5000548) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.

4. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
