PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Professional Engineering Section ("Section").

The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lockwood Greene Engineers is registered in the State of Wisconsin as an Architectural or Engineering Corp. re a Certificate of Authorization #11-2273. This certificate was first granted on 11/12/97 and is current through January 31, 2008.
2. Lockwood Greene Engineers (Lockwood) last reported address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing ("Department") is: 11301 Carmel Commons Blvd., Ste 304, Charlotte, NC 28226-5305.
3. On or about May 15, 2006, the North Carolina Board of Examiners for Engineers and Surveyors issued a cease and desist letter to Lockwood. The board action was based on findings that Lockwood offered to practice or practiced engineering in North Carolina without being issued a license. A copy of the North Carolina Bulletin from November 2006, is attached as Exhibit B and is incorporated into this document.
4. Lockwood complied with the cease and desist letter and no further action was taken.

5. Additionally, Lockwood failed to notify the Department of the disciplinary actions that it received in North Carolina.
6. In resolution of this matter, Lockwood Greene Engineers consents to the entry of the following Conclusions and Order.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Professional Engineers Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondent Lockwood Greene Engineers has violated:

a. Wis. Admin. Code §§ A-E 8.03(3)(a) and A-E 8.09(1) and Wis. Stat. § 443.11(1)(e) by violating state laws and administrative rules relating to the practice of professional engineering;

b. Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.08(1) by failing to furnish the Professional Engineers Section with information that he had been disciplined in another state.

### ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.

1. **Lockwood Greene Engineers**, Certificate of Authorization #11-2273 be, and hereby is, **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT:

2. Respondent shall, within 60 days of the date of this Order, pay costs in the amount of \$200.00. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

In the event Respondent fails to timely submit any payment as ordered, such violation may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and the Respondent's license SHALL BE SUSPENDED without further notice or hearing. The Respondent SHALL REMAIN SUSPENDED until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order. The Board in its discretion may alternatively impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file, **07 ENG 001** be, and hereby is, closed.
