PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Department Secretary. The Department Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

The Department Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kurt A. Grimm (“Respondent”), date of birth 02/16/59, is licensed as a private security person having license #108 00389. This license was first granted on 07/01/97.
2. The last reported address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing (“Department”) for the Respondent is: P.O. Box 113, Augusta, Wisconsin 54722.
3. On or about August 28, 2006, Mr. Grimm submitted a renewal application for a Private Security Permit. The renewal application requires that that the applicant answer the following question:

Have you ever been convicted within the past two years of a felony, a misdemeanor or a violation of any state or local law (other than traffic) that is punishable by a forfeiture, or, are charges pending?
(If yes provide information.)

Mr. Grimm checked the box marked “Yes” and submitted information notifying the Department he had received a non-criminal ordinance violation conviction for disorderly conduct on May 12, 2006. According to certified court records, the disorderly cc charged stemmed from a February 20, 2006 citation that was issued to the Respondent by the Department of Natural Resourc (DNR). The DNR citation was issued to the Respondent for transporting an uncased firearm in a vehicle. A true and correct c the court records relevant to this violation is attached as **Exhibit A** and is incorporated by reference.

4. On or about January 4, 2007, the Respondent received another non-traffic ordinance violation from the DNR for “hunti within fifty (50) feet of road’s center.” A true and correct copy of the court records relevant to this violation is attached as **Exl** and is incorporated by reference.

5. The Department’s investigation revealed that the Respondent failed to report both of the above-noted violations within the forty-eight (48) hour time period, as required by Wis. Stats. §§ 440.26 (4m); 440.26 (6)(a)1.; and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01 (2).

6. In resolution of this matter, the Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.21.

2. The Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44 (5).

3. Respondent, Kurt A. Grimm has violated:

Wis. Stats. §§ 440.26 (4m); 440.26 (6)(a)1.2. and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01 (2) by failing to report two non-criminal ordinance violations within the forty-eight hour time period as specified by law.

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The attached Stipulation is herby accepted.
2. Respondent Kurt A. Grimm, license #108 00389, be, and hereby is, REPRIMANDED.
3. Respondent Kurt A. Grimm, shall, within 90 days of the date of this Order, pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that in the event that Kurt A. Grimm fails to timely submit payment of the costs as set forth above, the private security permit for Kurt A. Grimm (# 108 00389) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further hearing and without further Order of the Department, and said suspension shall continue until the full amount of said costs has been paid to the Department of Regulation and Licensing and their failure to pay the costs shall be considered a violation of this Order by the Department.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that file 06 RSG 049, be and hereby is, closed as to Respondent Kurt A. Grimm.
