On November 3, 2008, the Wisconsin Barber and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board) reviewed a petition by Darshel R. Harris for a new payment schedule so she can fulfill the Board's December 4, 2004 Order. The December 6, 2004, Order required Ms. Harris to pay \$4,000.00 in forfeitures and \$2,000.00 in costs to the Department of Regulation and Licensing's (Department) Monitor and it established a payment schedule. Ms. Harris made no payments to the Department Monitor and as a result her apprenticeship permit was suspended on June 20, 2006.

On February 19, 2007, Ms. Harris petitioned the Board to reinstate her apprenticeship permit and to issue a modified payment schedule. On April 3, 2007, the Board issued an Order reinstating the respondent's apprenticeship permit pending receipt of specified payments. Ms. Harris failed to make any payment and her permit was not reinstated.

By letter dated August 18, 2008, Ms. Harris asked the Board to create a new payment schedule for her. Ms. Harris states that she would like to pay her fines and return to work. Ms. Harris recently paid the department \$2,000.00 as an initial payment toward the costs that were assessed against her.

After deliberation at its November 3, 2008, Board meeting, the Board decided to establish a new payment schedule for Darshel R. Harris and to lift the suspension of her apprenticeship permit if specific conditions are met. Ms. Harris' apprenticeship permit has expired and Ms. Harris will be able to apply for a new apprenticeship permit if the conditions of this Order are met

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, the suspension of Darshel R. Harris' apprenticeship permit will be removed if Ms. Harris pays \$676.60 to the Department Monitor within 90 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, Ms. Harris shall make monthly payments to the Department Monitor of \$150.00 beginning January 1, 2009, and on the first day of every month thereafter until the amount owed is paid in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that payments shall be made by certified check or money order, payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and licensing and sent to: Department Monitor, Division of Enforcement, Department of Regulation and Licensing, PO Box 8935, Madison, WI 53708-8935.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that if Darshel R. Harris fails to timely submit any payment as set forth above, Darshel R. Harris' apprenticeship permit will be suspended without an opportunity for a hearing and without further Order of the board. Failure to make a timely payment is a violation of this Order.
