On July 23, 2008, the State of Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board reviewed the documentation submitted in support of the petition by Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., for a three-month stay of suspension, as provided within the board's *Final Decision and Order* dated June 22, 2005. ("*Order*") Also requested was a reduction in drug and alcohol screens to a frequency of 48 per year as provided by paragraph C.14. of the *Order*, and the granting of four additional (4) hours to be worked as a pharmacist in charge as provided by paragraphs C.21 and D.4. of the *Order*. (Currently at 8 hours.)

Based upon the board's review:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., is granted a three month stay of the suspension of license # 12694, to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that the request to reduce drug and alcohol screens required by the *Order* to a frequency of 48 per year, is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that Heidi M. Timmerman, R.Ph., is granted a total of twelve (12) hours to be worked as a pharmacist in charge at the Agnesian HealthCare pharmacy.
