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On August 14, 2008, the Chiropractic Examining Board filed its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the board ordered that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against respondent. Pursuant to sec. RL 2.18 (4), Wis. Admin. Code, on or about August 18, 2008, the Chiropractic Examining Board received the Affidavits of Costs in the amount of \$1,086.35, filed by Attorney Jeanette C. Lytle. On or about August 25, 2008, the Chiropractic Examining Board received the Affidavit of Costs of the Office of Legal Counsel in the amount of \$318.50, filed by Administrative Law Judge William A. Black. The court reporter costs of \$180.50 are assessed in this order and an order of the Board of Nursing. Therefore, one-half of the court reporter costs are included in this Order Fixing Costs making the total costs of the Office of Legal Counsel \$228.25. The Chiropractic Examining Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on October 16, 2008, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$1,314.60, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Jeanette C. Lytle and Administrative Law Judge William A. Black, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against respondent, and shall be payable by respondent to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. **Failure of respondent to make payment on or before November 16, 2008, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless respondent petitions for and the board grants a different deadline.** Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Regulation and Licensing may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the respondent until respondent has made payment to the department in the full amount assessed.
