PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Susan G. Aune, (Date of Birth: July 23, 1966) is duly licensed as a barbering or cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #81-29443). This license was first granted on May 1, 2003, and is current until March 31, 2009. The last address Ms. Aune reported to the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) is 4320 Tabor Road, Racine, Wisconsin 53402
- 2. On August 10, 2007, Department Investigator Candace Bloedow observed Ms. Aune providing barbering and cosmetology services at 4320 Tabor Road, Racine, Wisconsin 53402. That address is the home of Ms. Aune. On August 10, 2007, the Tabor Road address was not licensed as a barbering or cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin.
- 3. On August 13, 2007, 4320 Tabor Road, Racine, Wisconsin was licensed as a barbering or cosmetology establishment, known as Susies Hair House.
 - 4. In resolution of this matter, Susan G. Aune consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15.

- 2. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 3. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Stat. § 454.08(1)(b). Except as permitted by rule promulgated under par. (a), no person may practice barbering or cosmetology, aesthetics, electrology or manicuring in an establishment unless the establishment is licensed to provide that practice under sub. (2).
- 4. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(c). Engaged in the practice of barbering or cosmetology, aesthetics, electrology or manicuring which evidences a lack of knowledge or ability to apply professional principles or skills.
- 5. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i). Any violation of Chapter 454 or of the Administrative Code promulgated under Chapter 454 is cause for discipline.
- 6. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(1). Licensees may not assist or participate in the unauthorized or unlicensed practice of barbering and cosmetology, aesthetics, electrology or manicuring.
- 7. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(2). Licensees shall report to the board unauthorized or unlicensed practice or other violations of ch. 454, Stats., and chs. BC 1 to 9.
- 8. By the conduct referred to in Finding of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.045(1). Licensees shall not provide personal care services outside of a licensed establishment except for person who are unable to leave their homes because of illness or disability or for persons who are in hospitals, nursing homes, correctional institutions or other institutions.
- 9. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Admin. Code \S BC 2.08(1)(b). Licensees holding current licenses or permits granted under ch. 454, Stats., shall:
 - (b) Be responsible for their own professional practice, conduct and compliance with ch. BC 2.
- 10. By the conduct referred to in Findings of Fact 2., Susan G. Aune has violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 3.01(1). Barbering and cosmetology, aesthetics, electrology and manicuring shall not be practiced outside the confines of a licensed establishment, except as provided in s. BC 2.045.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Susan G. Aune shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of FIVE HUNDRED dollars (\$500.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Susan G. Anne shall also pay costs to the Department of Regulation and Licensing in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIX dollars (\$525.00).

IT IS FURTHER ordered that a down payment of costs and forfeiture in the amount of \$128.00 shall be submitted within thirty (30) days from the effective date of this Order. Seven further payments of costs and forfeiture in the amount of \$128.00 shall be due every ninety (90) days from the previous payment until the full ONE THOUSAND TWENTY-FIVE dollars (\$1,025.00) is paid

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Susan G. Aune fails to timely submit any payment of the forfeiture and costs as set forth above, the barbering or cosmetology manager license of Susan G. Aune (license number 81-29443) **SHALL BE SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Susan G. Aune has complied with the terms of this Order.

This Order shall become effective upon the date of its signing.

It is hereby stipulated between Susan G. Aune, and John C. Temby, Attorney for the Department of Regulation and Licensing, Division of Enforcement, as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of an investigation by the Division of Enforcement (07 BAC 105). Ms. Aune consents to the resolution of this investigation by stipulation and without the issuance of a formal complaint.
- 2. Ms. Aune understands that by the signing of this Stipulation she voluntarily and knowingly waives her rights, including: the right to a hearing on the allegations against her, at which time the state has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses; the right to call witnesses on her behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena; the right to testify herself; the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision; the right to petition for rehearing; and all other applicable rights afforded to her under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes and the Wisconsin Administrative Code.
- 3. Ms. Aune is aware of her right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal advice prior to signing this stipulation.
- 4. Ms. Aune agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Ms. Aune waives all rights to any appeal of the attached order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Enforcement for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the
- Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Enforcement and any member of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Ms. Aune or her attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with the Board's deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such case advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Ms. Aune is informed that should the Board adopt this stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Departmental policy.
- 8. The Division of Enforcement joins Susan G. Aune in recommending the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
