PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent **Hot Spot** is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a barbering and cosmetology establishment, license # 80-33938. This license was first granted to it on 04/24/06 and is current through 03/31/09. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for this establishment is 628 Water Street, Eau Claire, WI 54703.
- 2. Respondent **Amy L. Brehm** is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a barbering or cosmetology practitioner, license # 82-83806. This license was first granted to her on 11/15/04 and is current through 03/31/09. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Ms. Brehm is 223 Twin Oak Drive, Altoona, WI 54720.
- 3. On August 29 and August 30, 2007, an investigator from the Department of Regulation and Licensing performed an inspection at Hot Spot.
- 4. The inspection revealed that Respondent Amy L. Brehm had an expired license. Ms. Brehm's license was due for renewal by June 30, 2007. Follow-up investigation revealed that Ms Brehm did not renew her license until August 30, 2007. The inspection revealed that Ms. Brehm provided barbering or cosmetology services to clients on at least four occasions during the time that her license was expired, and had other scheduled appointments that were "no shows" during that time period.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. Respondent **Amy L. Brehm** has violated Wis. Stat. § 454.04(1)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § 2.04(1) by engaging in the practice of barbering and cosmetology while her license was expired.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Respondent **Amy L. Brehm** (license # 82-83806) is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Respondent **Amy L. Brehm** shall, within 30 days of the date of this Order, pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$100.00 and shall pay COSTS in the amount of FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00).

- 4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may, in the alternative, impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent Amy L. Brehm fails to timely submit any payment as ordered, then her license (#82-83806) SHALL BE SUSPENDED without further notice or hearing until she has complied with the terms of this Order.
 - 5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
