PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Barbering and Cosmetology Board (Board). The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Kendra L. Smith (DOB 09/05/1960) is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin (license #81-28026). This license was first granted on October 12, 1999, and is current until March 31, 2009.
- 2. Marvin F. Smith (DOB 06/01/1966) is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology practitioner in the state of Wisconsin (license # 82-73291). This license was first granted on March 23, 1993, and is current until March 31, 2009.
- 3. Respondent Smiths' most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 1548 Grange Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53405.
- 4. Making Changes Inc. is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology establishment in the state of Wisconsin (license # 80-35815). This license was first granted on March 31, 2008, and is current until March 31, 2009.
- 5. The most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Making Changes Inc. (Changes) is 2718 Sixteenth Street, Racine, Wisconsin 53405.

- 6. On March 6, 2008, Investigator Willie Garrette made an inspection visit to Changes.
- 7. Investigator Garrette observed Marvin F. Smith performing a highlighting service for a client.
- 8. Investigator Garrette observed Kendra L. Smith shampooing a client's hair.
- 9. Investigator Garrette saw that there were no licenses posted as required by law.
- 10. When asked for their licenses, Mr. and Ms. Smith produced licenses that had expired on June 30, 2007.
- 11. Mr. and Mrs. Smith also gave Investigator Garrette a license for Kendra's Hair Design at 2714 Sixteenth Street. That license had also expired on June 30, 2007.
- 12. Investigator Garrette issued to the Smiths a Notice of Compliance ordering them to renew their individual licenses and to obtain an establishment license for Changes.
- 13. The Smiths renewed their licenses and obtained an establishment license for Changes on March 31, 2008

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.44 (5).
- 2. By providing barbering and cosmetology services at a time when his license was in expired status, Mr. Smith violated Wis. Administrative Code BC 2.04 (1).
- 3. By providing barbering and cosmetology services at a time when her license was in expired status, Ms. Smith violated Wis. Administrative Code BC 2.04 (1).
- 4. By providing barbering and cosmetology services in an unlicensed establishment, Mr. and Ms. Smith violated Wis. Administrative Code §§ BC 2.045 (1) and BC 3.01 (1).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The licenses of Kendra L. Smith, Marvin F. Smith and Making Changes Inc. to practice barbering and cosmetology in the state of Wisconsin are hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Respondents shall also be assessed jointly and severally a forfeiture of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) and the costs of this proceeding in the amount of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars, for a total due of three thousand three hundred (\$3,300.00) dollars. Respondents shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this order, jointly and severally make the first payment of three hundred dollars (\$300.00). Payments of three hundred dollars shall be made every ninety (90) days thereafter until the forfeiture and costs are paid. - 3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to submit timely any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, or fail to pay costs as ordered, Respondents' licenses (## 81-28026, 82-73291, and 80-35815) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing until Respondents have complied with the terms of this Order.
- 4. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
