PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board"). The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this mater adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jeremy P. Stender, D.C., (DOB 03/17/1970) is duly licensed as a chiropractor in the state of Wisconsin (license # 12-3733). This license was first granted on December 21, 2000.
- 2. Dr. Stender's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board is 204 Rice Ct., Eau Claire, WI 54701.
- 3. An informal complaint received by the Chiropractic Examining Board alleges that Dr. Stender made inappropriate, sexually harassing remarks to a coworker regarding a chiropractic assistant, who was also a patient.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 446.03, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §227.44(5).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Jeremy Stender, D.C. will, within one hundred eight (180) days of the date of this Final Decision And Order, take and complete eight (8) hours of Category 1 continuing education in patient boundaries. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be preapproved by the Chiropractic Examining Board or its designee. Dr. Stender will be responsible for locating courses satisfactory to the Chiropractic Examining Board and for obtaining the required approval of the courses from the Chiropractic Examining Board or its designee. Dr. Stender will within 60 days of completion of this educational requirement file an affidavit with the Chiropractic Examining Board stating under oath that he has attended in its entirety each of the courses approved for satisfaction of this requirement along with supporting documentation of attendance from the sponsoring organizations. Dr. Stender will make every reasonable effort to take and complete these courses within the 180 day time frame, but if he can prove to the board's satisfaction that he was unable to take and complete the courses despite reasonable efforts, the board may extend the timeframe for taking the courses. The affidavit and the supporting documentation of attendance will be filed with:

All certifications, affidavits or other documents required to be filed with the Chiropractic Examining Board will be deemed filed upon receipt by the Department Monitor.

2. Dr. Stender will be responsible for paying the full cost of attendance at these courses. Dr. Stender will not apply any of the continuing education credits earned in satisfaction of this Order toward satisfaction of his § 446.02(1)(b), Stats., and Wis. Admin. Code Ch. 5 biennial training requirements.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

3. Dr. Stender shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty dollars (\$250.00). Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

- 4. In the event Dr. Stender fails to timely pay costs as ordered or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education, Dr. Stender's license (#12-3733) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Dr. Stender has complied with the terms of this Order. The Board or its designee will remove the suspension, if provided with sufficient information that Dr. Stender is in compliance with the Order and that it is inappropriate for the suspension to remain in effect. The Board in its discretion may impose additional conditions and limitations for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.
 - 5. Dr. Stender is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Final Decision and Order.
 - 6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
