The Dentistry Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on March 4, 2009.

BACKGROUND

On January 9, 2002, based upon a Stipulation signed by the parties, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending the license of Blair D. Moldenhauer to practice dentistry for an indefinite period of time. Dr. Moldenhauer's license was also Limited subject to compliance with numerous requirements. On January 17, 2002, the Board granted Dr. Moldenhauer's request to stay the suspension of his license for a 3-month period. At various times since January 9, 2002, the Board has granted Dr. Moldenhauer's requests to modify the January 9, 2002 Final Decision and Order and to stay the suspension of his license. On November 5, 2008, the Board issued an Order Granting A Stay and Modifying Limitations. The modifications granted in the November 5, 2008 Order included, but are not limited to the following:

12. Limitation number eighteen (18) is modified to state that: Respondent shall obtain and pay for the services of a Mentor acceptable to the Board to monitor Respondent's professional practice. The Mentor must be a dentist currently licensed to practice in the state of Wisconsin. The Mentor shall conduct at least a monthly meeting with Respondent, a review of patient records selected by the Mentor, and any other action deemed appropriate by the Mentor to determine that Respondent is continuing to practice in a professional and competent manner. In the event that the Mentor is unwilling or unable to continue to serve, the Board or its designee in its sole discretion may select a successor. The Mentor shall have no duty or liability to any patient or third party, and the Mentor's sole responsibility is to the Board. The Board also added the following limitation:

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the following limitations are added to Respondent's license:

1. There must be another licensed dentist in the office at all times that Respondent is practicing. The other dentist may not be an employee of Respondent.

At its meeting on March 4, 2009, the Board considered Dr. Moldenhauer's request to modify its November 5, 2008 Order. In his request, Dr. Moldenhauer sought permission to check his Mentor's "hygiene patients and to field dental emergencies" during the two week period while his Mentor was on a medical mission in Central America. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED Dr. Moldenhauer's request to modify the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated January 9, 2002, in the manner described above be, and hereby is, Denied.

The effective date of this Order is March 4, 2009.
