On May 7, 2009, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of her registered nurse nursing license which had been suspended on March 12, 2004 for failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the Final Decision and Order dated November 7, 2003. The information of record shows that Petitioner was required to pass a rehabilitation review prior to petitioning for reinstatement of her license. The information presented shows that petitioner passed the rehabilitation review on April 9, 2009, and that it has been more than 5 years since the last renewal of her license. Accordingly, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for reinstatement of the license of COLETTE B. TROTTA, R.N. (lic. #136257-30) to practice as a registered nurse is hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in lieu of reinstatement, the petitioner shall be issued a LIMITED license for the sole purpose of completing a board-approved nurse refresher course., and which shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the course, petitioner's license shall be reinstated.
