## IN THE MATTER OF THE DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS AGAINST

### ORDER GRANTING STAY OF SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION OF ORDER LS0506221PHM

The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on February 4, 2009.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On June 22, 2005, based upon a Stipulation signed by Ms. Timmerman, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Ms. Timmerman's license to practice as a pharmacist for an indefinite period of time. The Order provided that at any time after six months from its effective date, the suspension shall be stayed upon Respondent providing proof of compliance with the provisions contained in Sections C and D of the Order and that Respondent's treater is of the opinion that she is able to safely practice pharmacy under the restrictions contained in the Order. At various times since the effective date of the Order, the Board granted stays of suspension of Ms. Timmerman's pharmacist license.

On or about December 8, 2008, Ms. Timmerman requested a stay of suspension of her license and elimination or reduction of her therapy. The Board considered Ms. Timmerman's request for a stay of suspension and modification of her therapy at its meeting on February 4, 2009. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

### **ORDER**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that the suspension of the license (#12694) of Heidi M. Timmerman to practice as a pharmacist is stayed for a period of three (3) months conditioned upon her compliance with the conditions and limitations set forth in the Order contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated June 22, 2005.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that** Ms. Timmerman's request to remove the therapy requirements set forth in paragraphs C.1.to C.6. of the Order contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated June 22, 2005 be, and hereby is, granted.
