The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on September 23, 2009.

BACKGROUND

On September 7, 2005, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Kiesling's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin for an indefinite period of time. The Order provided that Mr. Kiesling could petition the board for a stay of suspension after two years and upon providing proof of compliance with the conditions stated therein, including a psychological evaluation, an appearance before the board and a statement from his treater with regard to whether Mr. Kiesling is able to safely practice pharmacy.

Mr. Kiesling appeared before the board on July 22, 2009 requesting a stay of suspension in which he presented his psychological evaluation and recommendation from his therapist. The Board deferred action, at that time, until the September meeting. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that due to his non-compliance with sections B.1., f. and g., and C. 14. (a), of the Final Decision and Order, Mr. Kurt Kiesling's request for a stay of the suspension of license #14006 to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, be and hereby is, Denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Kurt Kiesling cannot repetition the Board for a stay of suspension until he is in compliance with sections C and D of the Order for a minimum of six (6) months. After that time, Mr. Kiesling may repetition the Board in accordance with section B. (1) of the Order.

The effective date of this Order is September 23, 2009.
