On February 26, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing granted the petitioner's request for stay of suspension and modification of the Final Decision and Order dated March 9, 2006, to discontinue her practice as an advance practice nurse prescriber in the field of anesthesia, but to allow her to practice as a registered nurse. The order stated as follows: *"Based upon the evidence presented which shows that the petitioner had a recent positive drug screen and has admitted a relapse to narcotic diversion at her workplace..."*

The underlying factual basis for granting the stay and modification is hereby amended to accurately reflect that the diverted medication was propofol which is a short-acting sedative agent commonly used in anesthesia, not classified as a narcotic. Also, the petitioner's diversion did not result in a positive drug screen as the medication typically wears off in minutes and it not included in the First Lab panel for drug screens. The remainder of the order is accurate and is not changed. This amended order is effective immediately and is retroactive to the date of its original signing on March 11, 2009.
