On April 2, 2009, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modifications to the Final Decision and Order dated July 13, 2006, to decrease the frequency of her drug screens. Based upon the information of record which shows that the petitioner has been in compliance with the terms and conditions of the order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications to the limited license of GWEN OLIVOTTI, L.P.N. (lic. #302654-31) to practice as a registered nurse is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of the petitioner's drug screens is hereby decreased to fourteen (14) times per year. All other terms of the order remain in effect.

The stay of suspension granted under the Board's original order is continuous and remains in effect until it is removed by the Board for non-compliance with the terms and conditions of the order.
