Based upon the information presented, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request by the petitioner, CHRISTINE BOHL, L.P.N. (lic. # 34002-31) for modifications of the restriction on her approved work site to allow her to work in nurse agency or home health setting is DENIED. The basis for the denial is the lack of adequate supervision available in those work settings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's drug screens shall be DECREASED to twenty-eight (28) per year plus one (1) annual hair test.
