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The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on April 8, 2009.

BACKGROUND

On June 27, 2007, based upon a Stipulation signed by Milwaukee Health Services, Inc, d/b/a MLK Heritage Pharmacy and Isaac Coggs Heritage Pharmacy, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending the pharmacy license (#42-8681) of MLK Heritage Pharmacy and the pharmacy license (#42-8664) of Isaac Coggs Heritage Pharmacy (Health Center) for an indefinite period of time. In its Order, the Board stayed the suspension of the pharmacy licenses for a period of 90 days from the date of the Order. The Order provided that the stay may be continued after the expiration of the 90-day period if Milwaukee Health Services petitioned the Board and proved that it satisfied the conditions set forth in the Order.

At some point in time prior to the February 4, 2009 Board meeting, Milwaukee Health Services requested a 90-day stay of the suspension of the pharmacy licenses of MLK Heritage Pharmacy and Isaac Coggs Heritage Pharmacy (Health Center). The Board granted Milwaukee Health Services' request for a stay of suspension at its meeting on February 4, 2009.

On or about April 1, 2009, Milwaukee Health Services requested a 90-day stay of the suspension of the pharmacy licenses of MLK Heritage Pharmacy and Isaac Coggs Heritage Pharmacy (Health Center). The Board considered Milwaukee Health Services' request for a stay of suspension at its meeting on April 8, 2009.

Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the licenses of MLK Heritage Pharmacy (#42-8681) and Isaac Coggs Heritage Pharmacy (Health Center) (42-8664) to practice as pharmacies is stayed through July 22, 2009 conditioned upon compliance with the conditions set forth in the Order contained in the Board's Final Decision and Order, dated June 27, 2007.

This order is effective on April 8, 2009.
