By its *Final Decision and Order* dated February 19, 2008, the Podiatrists Affiliated Credentialing Board (Board) reprimanded Dr. Boudreau and limited his license to practice as a podiatrist. Under the terms of the Board’s Order, Dr. Boudreau was required to complete three hours of continuing education in the area of ethics and to pay the costs of the proceedings.
