The Pharmacy Examining Board considered this matter at its meeting on April 8, 2009.

**BACKGROUND**

On April 9, 2008, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Mr. Van Buren's license to practice as a pharmacist in the State of Wisconsin, but staying that suspension subject to certain conditions. Specifically, the condition stated in paragraph C.4., requiring weekly therapy sessions and paragraph C.22., restricting Mr. Van Buren from practicing as a pharmacist in charge, only by permission of the Board.

On or about, March 18, 2009, Mr. Van Buren petitioned the Board to modify the Order by reducing the number of therapy sessions from weekly to every other week and granting the right to work for eight (8) hours as the pharmacist in charge. Based upon all the information of record, the Board orders the following:

**ORDER**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that Mr. Van Buren's petition to reduce the number of therapy sessions from weekly to every other week and granting the right to work for eight (8) hours as the pharmacist in charge, pursuant to license, # 12259, in the state of Wisconsin, be and hereby is, Granted.

The effective date of this Order is April 8, 2009.
