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PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Wisconsin Barber and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board) suspended the Petitioner's practitioner's license in an Order dated September 8, 2008. That Order allows the Petitioner to request a Stay of the suspension from the Board if she is in compliance with the Order. The Petitioner has petitioned the Board for a stay of the suspension of her practitioner's license. The Board reviewed her petition at its September 14, 2009 meeting.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Petitioner completed a 28-day residential AODA treatment program from July 7, 2006 through August 18, 2006.
- 2. The Petitioner reports that she is attending AA/NA meetings.
- 3. The Petitioner is not current with urine specimen tests because she is having a hard time paying for the tests.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stats. s. 454.15 (2) (a).
- 2. The Petitioner is in violation of the Board's September 8, 2008 Order because she is not current with urine specimen tests.
 - 3. The terms and conditions of the September 8, 2008 Order remain in effect.

ORDER

THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Reesasue L. Pieper's Petition for a Stay of her Suspension is denied.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that Reesasue L.Pieper may repetition the Board for a Stay when she has three negative urine screen tests in a one month period preceding the petition.
