On September 3, 2009, the petitioner appeared before the Wisconsin Board of Nursing in support of his request for full reinstatement of his license or in the alternative modifications to the Final Decision and Order dated October 2, 2008. Based upon the information presented showing that the petitioner has been in compliance with the terms and conditions of the order but has not fulfilled the requisite five years of monitored practice, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that request for full reinstatement of the registered nurse license of DAVID P. CROSS, R.N., (lic. # 146614-30) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's urinalysis screens shall be decreased to fourteen (14) times per year with one additional annual hair test, until such time as petitioner is employed as a nurse.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED petitioner's order shall be modified to allow him access to controlled substances for administration to patients at a worksite. The Board would consider granting worksite approval to an agency position with one site placement.
