PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Dentistry Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Alexander Pijpaert, D.D.S., (“Respondent”) was born on August 20, 1954, and is licensed to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 4898. This license was first granted on June 6, 1997,.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board is 3400 Intertech Drive, #100, Brookfield, Wisconsin 53045.
3. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent was working as a dentist at Brookfield, Wisconsin.
4. Patient J. T. is a male, born on November 9, 1934.
5. Patient J.T. had a root canal on tooth #13 performed by Respondent in January, 2004. On February 3, 2004, tooth #13 was prepared for a porcelain veneer crown.

6. On February 12, 2004, Patient J.T. presented at Respondent's office to have a permanent crown permanently cemented on his tooth # 13. Respondent permitted his dental assistant to seat and cement the crown.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 447.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph #6, above does not comply with the requirements of Wis. Stat. § 447.065 and, therefore the Respondent violated Wis. Stat. § 447.07(3)(f).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Alexander Pijpaert, D.D.S., is hereby REPRIMANDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent shall, within 180 days from the date of this Order, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$475.00. Payment shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:

3. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to pay costs as ordered the Respondent's license (#4898) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
