PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Carla M. Seifert (DOB 10/20/1947) is duly licensed as a barbering and cosmetology manager in the State of Wisconsin (license # 81-15142). This license was first granted on 11/04/1980.
- 2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 1440 South Union Street, Shawano, WI 54166.
- 3. At all times relevant to this action, Respondent was working as a barbering and cosmetology manager at Carla and the Designers, 140 South Main Street, Shawano, WI 54166.
- 4. From at least the year 2000 until March 15, 2006, Respondent rented space to Bonnie L. Anderson for use as an electrology establishment.
- 5. Respondent did not have a written lease agreement with Anderson until approximately March 21, 2006.
- 6. Wisconsin Administrative Code § BC 3.02 (2) (a) requires a lease agreement between an owner and a licensed individual to be in writing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15 (2), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 227.44 (5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph five above constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § BC 3.02 (2) (a).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the license of Carla M. Seifert (#15142-81) is REPRIMANDED.

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that Respondent Carla M. Seifert shall pay to the Department of Regulation and Licensing a forfeiture of THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent shall pay costs in the amount of EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$800.00).

Payment of the forfeiture and costs shall be submitted in eight (8) installments. The installments shall be submitted on the following payment schedule:

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to submit timely any payment of the forfeiture as set forth above, or fails to pay costs as ordered, or fails to comply with the ordered continuing education, Respondent's license (#15142-81) SHALL BE SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing until Respondent has complied with the terms of this Order.
