PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Regulation and Licensing (Secretary). The Secretary has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Secretary adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Gregor Mieder (Respondent), whose date of birth is August 4, 1979, held a license as a private detective in the state of Wisconsin (# 63-11274). Mr. Mieder was first issued his license as a private detective on April 26, 2007, and the license expired on August 31, 2008. Mr. Mieder’s last address of record with the Department of Regulation and Licensing is 102 East Gorham Street, Madison, WI 53703.
- Mieder Investigations, LLC holds a private detective agency license in the state of Wisconsin (# 62-16569). The

license was first issued on April 26, 2007 and is current through August 31, 2009. The last address of record with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Mieder Investigations, LLC is 102 East Gorham Street, Madison, WI 53703.

3. Information received by the Department of Regulation and Licensing indicates that the required liability insurance coverage for Mieder Investigations, LLC lapsed on June 1, 2008.
4. Mr. Mieder indicates that Mieder Investigations, LLC ceased operations on June 10, 2008.
5. Mr. Mieder failed to notify the Department of Regulation and Licensing and surrender his agency license when he closed his private detective agency, Mieder Investigations, LLC.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6).
2. The Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
3. Respondents Gregor Mieder and Mieder Investigations, LLC have violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL 31.034 and § RL 35.01(11) by failing to maintain a bond or liability policy, as set forth above in paragraphs 3-4 of the Findings of Fact. As a result, Respondents are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6).
4. Respondents Gregor Mieder and Mieder Investigations, LLC have violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL 32.08 by failing to notify the department and surrender the agency license within 30 days after termination of the agency. As a result, Respondents are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6).

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Department of Regulation and Licensing hereby accepts the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the private detective license of Gregor Mieder (# 63-11274).
2. The Department of Regulation and Licensing hereby accepts the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER of the private detective agency license of Mieder Investigations, LLC (#62-16569).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

3. Gregor Mieder and Mieder Investigations, LLC shall, within 30 days of the date of this order, submit all indicia of licensure to the Department of Regulation and Licensing. All indicia of licensure shall be sent to:

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that file 08 RAL 058 be closed.
